Eph. 5:1-21

1. Walk in LOVE. (v. 2)

God's love is **PERFECT**, man's love is **SELFISH**.

“Love is the willing, joyful desire to put the welfare of others above our own.”

We are to **ACT** as love acts. (1 Cor. 13)

“We make a very small package when we get all wrapped up in **OURSELVES**.” –Lloyd Ogilvie

2. Walk as children of LIGHT. (v. 8)

Once you were **DARKNESS**, but now you are **LIGHT**.

The kingdom of God is **LIGHT**.

The kingdom of Satan is **DARKNESS**.

3. Walk CIRCUMSPECTLY. (v. 15)

Not as **FOOLS**, but as **WISE**.

Time is a God-given **STEWARDSHIP**.

The **WILL** of God is found in the **WORD** of God.

In the Bible, the word “**FILLED**” means to be **CONTROLLED** by.
