-Contentment is being totally satisfied regardless of the circumstances of life; internal satisfaction or rest which does not demand changes in external circumstances.		
-Paul learned to delight in his difficulties because he understood the recipe for contentment is not answered prayer, but to live in God's grace.		
-Sovereignty of God means: He is the Most High, Lord of heaven and earth. Subject to none. Influenced by none, absolutely independent. God does as He pleases, only as He pleases and always as He pleases. None can thwart Him and none can hinder him. (Arthur Pink)
