**Prophecies of Peace**

Deut. 18:18-19; Is. 53:4-6; Gen. 3:14-15

**1. He speaks** \_\_\_\_\_ . (Deut. 18:18-19)

A prophet is coming who will be “like Moses.” That prophet can only be \_\_\_\_\_.
