

**The Bread of Life, Part 2**

John 6:22-40

**1. It is \_\_\_\_\_ . (vv. 22-27, 30-36)**

First, Jesus rebuked them for their focus on \_\_\_\_\_ things. (vv. 26-27)

Rather than focusing on the decaying outer man, they needed to seek \_\_\_\_\_ nourishment.

In response they ask for *another* \_\_\_\_\_ that they might believe in Him. (vv. 30-34)

They not only want more bread, as we've already mentioned, they want Jesus to prove He's \_\_\_\_\_ than Moses and is their Messiah.

Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ is the Bread of Life. (vv. 35-36)

I AM the bread of life means that Jesus is the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of spiritual life.

But in order to have the kind of life Jesus has been talking about, we need to \_\_\_\_\_ in Him.

**2. It is by \_\_\_\_\_, not by works. (vv. 28-29, 37-40)**

Even though they understand He is talking about spiritual things, they automatically assume that there is some kind of \_\_\_\_\_ they need to do to earn this eternal life.

There is nothing you can do to earn salvation. The work that God wants you to do is to \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus!

But it takes more than our faith to be saved. It also takes the \_\_\_\_\_ . (vv. 37-40)

\_\_\_\_\_ who is saved must freely decide to believe in Jesus and come to Him.

But also God must sovereignly \_\_\_\_\_ us, or elect us, for salvation (vv. 37, 39).

The wonderful way that Jesus puts it here teaches us that all who are saved are a \_\_\_\_\_ from the Father to the Son.

And, of course, our Lord would never \_\_\_\_\_ one who comes as a love gift from the Father.
